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## Gold Standard Local Stakeholder Consultation Report

### SECTION A. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

#### A. 1. Project eligibility under the Gold Standard

This project will introduce energy efficient cook stoves within the Meru District, Tanzania and will reduce fuel use and associated greenhouse gas emissions by end users. Other benefits will include contributions to local issues such as deforestation and illnesses caused by smoke inhalation. This is in line with the stated aims of the GS.

The project will be classified as small scale, with a maximum estimated emissions reduction of 51 141 tonnes CO<sub>2</sub>e/year, when applying the 180 GWhth limit specified by the UNFCCC. The project will be carried out inline with the Gold Standard methodology “Technologies and Practices that displace Decentralized Thermal energy consumption”.

The project falls into the end-use energy efficiency improvement category, defined as the reduction in the amount of energy required for delivering or producing non-energy physical goods or services.

The project type eligibility is outlined in Annex C of the gold standard methodology v2.1 under “Improved distributed heating and cooking devices (e.g. biodigesters, cook-stoves), and distributed micro-scale electricity generation units (e.g. micro hydro and PV for households)”.

Eligibility criteria:

“Project activities involving a large amount of small, distributed heating, cooking or electricity generation devices using renewable energy sources shall provide the Gold Standard with a clear description of the transfer of credits ownership all along the investment chain, and with proof that end users are aware of and willing to give up their rights on emission reductions.”

Following free distribution of stoves, end users will be made aware that all credits generated will be transferred to co2balance and that in receiving the technology without payment they agree to this transfer. The project will reduce the production of carbon dioxide (CO<sub>2</sub>), methane (CH<sub>4</sub>) and nitrous oxide (N<sub>2</sub>O). The project is located in Tanzania, a Least Developed Country (LDC) on the OECD Development Assistance Committees’ Overseas Development Assistance recipient list<sup>1</sup>; this project however will not be a recipient of any ODA. A signed declaration attesting to this will be provided during validation and will appear in the GS passport for this project.

Major stove components are specific to the co2balance design and so are sourced by co2balance and supplied to stove contractors in kit form. Basic materials such as sand and cement are sourced by stove manufacturers. co2balance ensures that as many materials as possible are locally produced.

#### **Project construction (January 2012 estimated)**

Following the establishment of project baseline and emission reductions, stoves will be constructed in batches up to the small-scale project limit.

##### ii. Non-technical summary

This project will involve the distribution of 20,000 energy efficient stoves within a number of wards in Meru District, near Arusha Tanzania. Most families in the area use the traditional 3-stone cooking stove that produces a big fire and consumes large amounts of firewood. This means that a lot of time is spent collecting firewood that would be used otherwise for other developmental activities. The three stone fire also produces a lot of smoke which causes respiratory disease, particularly in women/girls who use it for cooking, but also in young children of both sexes and other people (e.g. the elderly) who spend a lot of time indoors. The use of this inefficient cooking method also has unintentional negative impacts on the environment surrounding local people.

The project will be attempting to address these issues by distributing energy efficient stoves to households in Meru District wards that in the absence of this project would cook primarily using traditional inefficient firewood stoves. The Stove to be constructed is the Carbon Zero Stove (CZS) stove, that saves over 50% firewood as compared to the three stone stove. The stoves will be constructed, distributed and installed by local people under the guidance of co2balance Tanzania Ltd. These stoves will utilise the efficient rocket technology. These stoves will be using less firewood and emitting less smoke, which will reduce daily firewood costs and alleviate illness caused by smoke inhalation.

The distribution of efficient stoves will result in emissions reductions associated with the reduction of the production and combustion of firewood derived from unsustainable sources.

In addition to reducing greenhouse gas emissions, so contributing to the mitigation of climate change, this project will contribute towards local benefits that will enhance the air quality in the

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area due to the reduction of the atmospheric pollutants.

Besides the benefits stated above, the project will provide the following co-benefits:

- Reduced deforestation and degradation of surrounding forests, as less wood will be needed to cook
- Reduced soil erosion and nutrient loss as trees protect the land
- Reduced risk of flooding in hilly areas as trees and plants on slopes soak up rain
- Reduced poverty, as the efficient wood stove reduces annual expenditure on cooking fuels;
- Reduced adverse health effects associated with indoor air particulate matter inhalation from the smoke due to the purpose-built stove design.
- Reduced cooking and wood collection time, which will allow more time to attend other household tasks and supervise children
- Reduced risk of attacks on firewood collectors (mainly women) in the remote areas generally used for firewood collection
- Reduction in burns and injuries as the CZG stove is safer to cook on

A UK-based environmental organisation co2balance - in collaboration with TAWIRI - plans to develop an efficient cook stove project near Arusha.

Our aim is to build approximately 20000 stoves in a number of wards in Meru district, including Poli, Nkoaranga, Usa River, Songoro, Nkoanrua, Akheri, Nkoarisambu, Seela Sing'isi, Makiba, Mbuguni, Maroroni, Kikwe, Leguruki, Kikatiti, Maji ya Chai, Ngarenanyuki and King'ori. ##### 1.0 Introduction

-After opening prayer, every participant of the meeting was given opportunity to introduce his/her self (Name, organization coming from, ward/village, position)

##### 2.0 Opening

- ✓ Jerome Kimaro, the Co2balance-TAWIRI project coordinator/manager briefed the meeting participants and guest of honor ( Arumeru District Commissioner) about the intended stove project and how it will benefit the local community at Meru ecologically, socially and economically. He also talked of the pilot project and the overall number of

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stoves expected to be constructed (20,000 and the selected wards for the pilot). He also talked of the criteria that was used for the feasibility study. Thereafter, he welcomed the DC for opening remarks.

- ✓ The meeting was officially opened by her excellence Mrs. Mercy Silla, the District Commissioner of Arumeru District on 10.15 am. The following are main issues which she highlighted;
  - Appreciation to Co2balance and TAWIRI to bring this project in Meru District Council area because majority of local people still use three stone stove that has adverse impact to natural environment and people
  - She admitted that the project area is currently under severe threat of tree cutting and acute shortage of cooking firewood which in turn has led to wildlife habitat loss, degradation of water sources, soil erosion in steep sloped areas, decrease in crop yield, increasing social conflicts due to water scarcity and poor household welfare in general.
  - All leaders from the district to village levels to support Co2balance-TAWIRI project team to make sure that the project will be successfully implemented and sustainable
  - She would like to see that Co2balance will implement the project as soon as possible and distribute enough stoves that will be able to offset the current ecological, social and economic problems.
  - The local government authority is willing to provide further administrative assistance that Co2balance-TAWIRI will seek in order to make the project successful at Meru

### 3.0 Project overview

- ✓ She first started by asking the audience how many people use firewood and about 97% of the crowd lifted up their hands. Then she assured them they were in the right place.
- ✓ She talked of the main goal of co2balance being fighting climate change
- ✓ She gave details about the company, talked of the head office in the U.K and all the other branches worldwide.
- ✓ She talked of co2balance partnering with different stakeholders all with a collective aim of conserving the environment reducing the cutting down of trees.
- ✓ She made it known to the audience that co2balance was opening new projects in Tanzania, Arusha being one of the areas, and asked for their maximum cooperation.
- ✓ She also elaborated on how the project was for the benefit of the community as it would offer employment opportunities and improve livelihoods.
- ✓ She talked of the contractor's role in the whole process from the feasibility phase to the construction phase.
- ✓ Finally she talked of the backtracking process and monitoring exercise, explained to the audience why they are done and asked them to be supportive whenever co2balance

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official go to their homesteads.

### 4.0 Play/Drama

Educative play was performed by Malihai Club, youth environment group based in USA river to show the advantages of Co2balance stove over that of three stone stove through drama. The drama group was trained by Mercy and Jerome and it was well done and the intended message reached the audience successfully.

### 5.0 The Carbon zero stove

After the Drama, Mercy approached the meeting from a participatory perspective by allowing the audience to participate. She asked them of what they had learnt from the play with regard to the problems of the three stone stove and the advantages of the carbon zero stove. After active participation from the stakeholders, she then summarized everything as follows:

- ✓ Problems of the three stone stove
  - Produces more smoke
  - Uses a lot of firewood
  - Takes a long time to cook food
  - Family conflicts
  - Health implications(infections from smoke)
  - Too much heat as heat is lost to the surrounding
  - Accidents/burns when cooking because of instability of the stones.
- ✓ Advantages of the new carbon zero stove
  - Improved health
  - Uses less firewood
  - Cooks food faster
  - Improved air quality/clean environment
  - Reduces heat loss to the surrounding.
- ✓ How to use the stove
  - Mercy explained to the audience what the stove was made of (metal plate, cylinder and the vacuum) and how it worked using a sample of a stove and a big chart.
  - She told them the stove was long lasting(7yrs lifespan)
  - She showed them where to put firewood and where to fan.

### 6.0 Sustainable development matrix

Mercy gave a detailed coverage on the sustainable development matrix with emphasis on the following:

- ✓ Air Quality
  - Reduced/less smoke emissions by the carbon zero stove will ensure clean air
- ✓ Water
  - Save on water as less water will be used to clean the cooking pot
  - Conserve water catchment areas by reduced deforestation
- ✓ Environment
  - The project aims at reducing environmental degradation, reduced deforestation and improved air quality contributes to a clean and healthy environment.
- ✓ Biodiversity

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- The project aims at biodiversity conservation by protecting various habitats e.g. trees and water catchment areas
- ✓ Livelihood of the poor/income generation
  - The project will be a source of employment to some people, and would improve people's livelihoods as they will use less money to buy firewood.
- ✓ Time
  - Households will save time as they will spend less time cooking and collecting firewood.

Mercy then thanked the audience for their time and cooperation and handed over to Jerome.

### 7.0 Question and answers session

Jerome Kimaro took the lead in this session where participants were given an opportunity to ask question/ comments/ opinion/ suggestions with regard to Co2balance stoves project in Arusha. The following were questions raised:

**1<sup>st</sup> question:** can you use charcoal with the carbon zero stoves?

**Answer:** Jerome answered, that only firewood can be used.

**2<sup>nd</sup> question:** can institutions get stoves

**Answer:** Jerome responded that their request will be submitted to relevant authorities and at the moment the project is only focusing domestic use

**3<sup>rd</sup> question:** Is there a possibility of getting a stove that can accommodate two cooking pots at the same time?

**Answer:** Mercy answered him that at the moment the design in use can only accommodate one cooking pot and that is what we are working with. She told him she will forward his request to the U.K office.

**4<sup>th</sup> question:** How many stoves will you build?

**Answer:** Jerome told him that 20,000 stoves will be built but that does not mean it is the end.

**5<sup>th</sup> question:** How soon will the project begin?

**Answer:** Mercy answered that as soon as the U.K office gives a green light. She also added that it may take a while as there are several things that have to be put in place before the project begins.

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Comments resulting from the stakeholders blind sustainable development matrix

The stakeholder's blind assessment exercise was tremendously positive. Many expressed their support for the project as it relates to Environmental, Economic and Social Impacts. The project has opened up new possibilities for women in an area where traditionally women have few opportunities. The project employs local women in the Data Collection Process. This puts women in a position of authority, keeps them active and involved in the community and not behind closed doors in a homestead, and equips them with the power to make decisions.

Women, who are usually in charge of cooking, are most at risk of chronic respiratory problems, such as chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD). Cutting down indoor air pollution will contribute to better respiratory health, in particular among young mothers spending time close to the fire after having given birth.

Typically the comments received from the stakeholders were positive and support the comments

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from the co2balance's own sustainable development matrix. 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### **SECTION F. DESCRIPTION OF THE DESIGN OF THE STAKEHOLDER FEEDBACK ROUND**

For the initial feedback right after the consultation and to help improve the LSC report Co2balance assigned specific individuals within the community the role of information dispersers. They were responsible for communicating directly with the individuals and women unable to attend. We provided them with project summaries and the relevant information required. Co2balance called them a week after the stakeholders meeting to gather feedback, and to find out if they were posed any questions that they were unable to respond to, and assist them in answering these questions. The feedback we have received has been entirely positive.

For the proper stakeholder feedback round after this LSC report is approved by the Gold Standard, a copy in the local language (Swahili) of the LSC report and feedback forms will be made publicly available in hard copy in the post office, the church and in the area chief's office during the feedback round. These will be collected and returned to the project developer at the end of the SFR.

Thus, a physical stakeholder feedback round (SFR) will not be carried out; instead, the option of making the LSCR and other relevant documentation available to the stakeholders will be taken as above. All stakeholders originally invited to the initial LSC (whether they attended or not) will be invited to take part in the SFR. The SFR will commence as soon as the project design document is complete and will run for 2 months.

In order to carry out a meaningful stakeholder feedback round Co2balance will notify the Gold Standard once all documentation is available, uploaded and ready to be made publicly available. The necessary documentation (LSC report, draft PDD and the passport) will be uploaded onto the Gold Standard registry and made publicly available as well on the co2balance website with feedback mechanisms clearly explained.






